Parents/Guardians:

Students in grades 7-12 will be taking their state tests the weeks of April 16-27. For the first week, students will take their tests in the morning from 7:50 – 9:50 AM and we will follow a two-hour delay schedule on each day of the week April 16th-20th. The schedule for testing in specific subjects are below.

High School

- English I / English II – April 16 (part 1)
- English I / English II – April 17 (part 2)
- Algebra I / Geometry – April 18 (part 1)
- Algebra I / Geometry – April 19 (part 2)
- Biology / Government – April 20 (both parts)
- US History – April 23 (both parts)

Middle School

- English – April 16 (part 1)
- English – April 17 (part 2)
- Math – April 18 (part 1)
- Math – April 19 (part 2)
- Science (8th grade) / Algebra Aptitude Test (7th grade) – April 20 (both parts)



Students have been made aware of their testing schedule and we encourage parents to make sure their child gets plenty of rest, eats a good breakfast packed with proteins (please cut back on the sugars☺) and comes to school ready to do their best and show what they know.

Some high school students may be re-taking a test to improve their scores. Students who are doing this will take their tests on the same days as noted above. If your child is not scheduled to take a test they may report to school by 9:50 AM.

Important: Transportation services will run a normal schedule. If your child does not have transportation to arrive at 9:50 AM, they will need to ride the bus at the normal time and report to study hall in the cafeteria during the morning hours.
